Taking Your Pills

DAY1 DAY₂ **Take Mifepristone Take Comfort Meds** Swallow first pill

(Mifepristone)

The next medication, Misoprostol, is taken 24hrs after Mifepristone.



30-60 minutes before you take

Misoprostol, take 1 ibuprofen pill for pain and 1 ondansetron pill for nausea

DAY 2-3 Take Misoprostol



24 hours after the first pill, after taking the comfort meds, take 4 tablets of Misoprostol.

Place 2 tablets in each lower cheek by the gums.

Additional Misoprostol (if needed)



DAY 2-3+

What to Expect

Leave the 4 pills in place for 30 minutes, then swallow any remaining pill fragments.

IF DIRECTED TO BY PROVIDER: Repeat the Misoprostol with 4 more tablets. 4 hours later

DAY 2-3

Continue Comfort Meds

For pain/cramping:

- Take 800mg ibuprofen every 8hrs.
- If more pain control is needed, you can take up to 1000mg Tylenol (acetaminophen) in between doses

For nausea:

 Take 4mg of Zofran (ondansetron) every 4-8 hours as needed



Anticipate cramping and bleeding, including clots - this means the pregnancy is passing. Use pads to track the level of bleeding

Nausea, fever and flu-like symptoms can be normal for 24hr after taking misoprostol

Period like bleeding may last for 2 weeks


Watch for symptoms of complications

Monitor Your Pads:



In person follow-up is not necessary. You can take a pregnancy test at home after 4-6 weeks. If you prefer, you may have an ultrasound done after 2 weeks to confirm you aren't pregnant sooner.
